PURPOSE: First Nations Development Institute, in collaboration with Acoma Department of Natural Resources, is hosting a **5-day Conservation Planning Training & Workshop**. Agricultural producers will be guided through the development of a conservation plan for their operation. Upon completion of the workshop, producers will have the majority of their conservation plan completed, and an opportunity to apply for USDA programs like the Environmental Quality Incentive Program (EQIP).

ELIGIBILITY: Registration is on a first come, first served basis and limited to 20 Native agricultural producers located within the Pueblo of Acoma community. Participants must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
