REQUEST FOR IMPACT STATEMENTS ON SEPTEMBER 2025 HAILSTORM EVENT

The Pueblo of Acoma is requesting **one-to-two-page impact statements** from community members whose homes were damaged during the September 28–29, 2025 storm. These statements will support the Pueblo's efforts to seek federal disaster assistance and to fully document the impacts to our community, including impacts to homes that serve important cultural and family purposes.

When responding to questions about cultural or traditional uses of your home, please do not share any confidential or culturally sensitive information. General descriptions of how your home is used and how it has been affected are sufficient and appropriate.

Community members are invited to share their experiences by responding to the questions below. You may answer as many questions as you are comfortable with. Your responses may be used to support the Pueblo's appeal for disaster assistance.

About Your Home

Please describe your home (for example: traditional materials, age if known, or how it was built).

Has your home been passed down through your family? If so, please describe.

Does your home serve any important family, cultural, or traditional purposes? Please explain.

Storm Damage

What damage did your home experience during the September 28–29 storm?

(For example: roof damage, water entering the home, wall damage, flooding, or other impacts)

Current Conditions

Is your home currently safe to enter? Please explain. Are you still using the home? If yes, what conditions are you experiencing?

Have you experienced any of the following:

- leaking roof or water inside the home
- flooding or standing water
- mold or moisture
- difficulty heating or staying warm

Who in your household has been most affected (elders, children, or others)?

Impacts to Family and Cultural Use

How has the damage affected your ability to use your home for family, cultural, or traditional purposes?

Are there activities that can no longer take place in your home because of the damage?

Does your home play a role in your family's responsibilities, identity, or connection to the community? If so, how has this been affected?

Financial and Repair Challenges

Have you tried to make repairs? If so, what challenges have you faced? Do you believe you can afford the repairs needed? Please explain.

Ongoing and Future Concerns

Has the condition of your home worsened due to weather since the storm? What concerns do you have if repairs are not made?
